The City of Rockport is hosting a hybrid Citizen Tourism Workshop on May 28th at 11:00 AM. The event will take place at the Rockport Service Center (2751 SH 35 Bypass) and will also be available via Zoom or livestream for those wishing to participate virtually.

This interactive workshop provides an opportunity for community members to learn about Rockport's tourism initiatives, share feedback, and discuss how residents can help promote tourism in the city. The workshop will focus on collaboration between the City and its residents to shape the future of tourism in Rockport. Additionally, it will offer step-by-step guidance on how tourism businesses can create a profile on the Visit Rockport/Fulton website, directly connecting with tourists.

While this is not a formal meeting, the City anticipates attendance by members of the City Council, Building & Standards Commission, Convention and Visitor Bureau Board, Parks Board, Planning & Zoning Commission, and Tree & Landscape Committee, which may constitute a quorum.
